Bio

Jacqueline Tiepermann is a Melbourne based artist who studied Graphic Art at East Sydney Technical College. Over the course of four decades Jacqueline, whilst running various successful businesses, has continued to paint mainly commissions for private and public areas. In 2010 Jacqueline had a highly successful solo show in Melbourne where the inaugural body of work called Viaggio was exposed. "Viaggio" is the journey of her own extraordinary life, using water as dialogue. Born and raised in a city famous for its harbour, its influences within her works are evident in her series of abstract paintings which represent the profound course of events that have occurred along her journey.

Jacqueline Tiepermann is a story teller reflecting on life. In a world that is fast paced, she encourages the viewer through her works to decelerate, immerse, examine and reflect on one's own history.

Artist's Statement

Viaggio reflects on a life spanning six decades, recounting a random series of personal experiences and emotional journeys. The large-scale paintings are sized to excite the visual senses, drawing the viewer in with the application of exhilarating colours and textures. On closer inspection you may well become aware of how carefully considered these layers of colours are placed. Various textures are described to depict the "winds of change". These, combined with other formal elements produce highly coded symbols, built according to her internal logic. It is not her intention for you to be privy to her private world, but rather for the viewer to be emotionally stirred and engaged.
