JOSE RAMON LOZANO

BURNING FLOWERS

MINI SOLO SHOW

"(In Burning Flowers) Lozano analyzes the symbolic underside of still life: the vanitas, that is, the reflection on the transience of life and the uselessness of worldly pleasures in the face of the certainty of death. To do this, he paints withered flowers whose beauty gravitates between the recent plenitude and the next decadence...As in his portraits, the artist focuses his attention on a transitory state that is intimately linked to the irremediable finiteness of everything that is breathed with life." - Statement by Carlos Delgado Mayordomo

Spanish born artist, Jose Ramon Lozano lives and works in Madrid. A painter and engraver, he graduated in Fine Arts by Granada University and began painting as soon as he finished his degree.

Lozano is an expressionistic painter, but portraiture is his speciality. The artist feels that the viewer connects with portraits more intimately, creating a dependent relationship with the subject and a powerful emotional connection.

His work is disturbing and moving. Confronting yet connecting. Despondent yet beautiful. Lozano's work immerses us in a world of contemplative images through depiction of erratic souls, whose eyes speak of glimpses of an elusive existence, allowing the viewer to contemplate these figures as themselves as if in a mirror.

PAOLO PILOTTI

QUEENLICIOUS

MINI SOLO SHOW

"My queens break the mould of portraiture that has imprisoned them for centuries, wearing and saying whatever they want!"

Paolo Pilotti was born in Rome in 1982 and attended the Roman Academy of Fine Arts with a major in anatomy. Irony and provocation are key subjects of his artistic agenda, this is communicated clearly in the satirical amalgamation of religious figures and modern pop cultural icons featured in his work.

Pilotti proficiently employs myriad colour in his work to harmonious and dramatic effect, while skilfully applying pattern in his design. His eloquent capture of the renaissance in his subjects is almost overlooked due to the equally accomplished nature of his form and drapery. However, his adherence to the period must be afforded special mention for its contribution to the all- encompassing meticulousness of his work.

The artists irreverent iconic subjects have allowed him to claim his place in the competitive Italian art arena, attributed to the recognizable characters, his confident critique of contemporary consumerist society and all its contradictions and flaws.

Throughout his career Pilotti has featured in numerous collaborations and periodicals throughout his native Italy. The artist has participated in various solo and group exhibitions in Europe. This is Pilotti's first show in Australia.

RAMONA NORDAL SOUL QUENCHER

MINI SOLO SHOW

"The show title evolved from my personal need to be quenched somehow creatively. I wanted these new pieces to focus on an evolution of colour, form and subject. Colour is a huge part of my work process - I wanted to incorporate something new for this show. I am continually pushing my boundaries in a way that showcases something progressive and new yet remains true to my style. I think it's these moments that are important and crucial to an artist's progression creatively. The essence of my subjects is the desire to be seen. Each of them driven in some way to tell their story through their form, vibrancy and depth. While all of them are different they come together as a family of misfits struggling to show you their world."

Canadian-born artist Ramona Nordal began her artistic pursuits at Emily Carr Institute of Art and Design in Vancouver, British Columbia, where she studied lithography, colour theory, painting and drawing and later focused on anatomy drawing and painting.

Colour theory has always been an integral part of Nordal's process who is rapidly becoming known for her richly evocative colour pallet tethered against, what appear to be, monochromatic subjects, but that are subtly infused with colour themselves.

WAYAN SARCITA YASA IAM SPACE AND TIME

MINI SOLO SHOW

"Art is a vehicle for processing feelings and thoughts from various experiences. It is influenced by the surrounding environment which encourages a person to present or describe a range of feelings. In this mini solo exhibition, I examine daily habits in the home and everyday life from my own personal experience, whether it's feelings of joy or sadness, or the many expressions that I show in spatial language. As such the title of this body of work is 'I am Space and Time.' "

Wayan Sarcita Yasa, known as Sarcita, is an emerging artist from Tabanan Bali. Sarcita is currently a student at the Indonesian Art Institute, Yogyakarta, and an alumnus of SMK N 1 Sukawati (SMSR).

As a young, melancholic artist, he incorporates many fundamental matters of life into his works, using it as a means of self-reflection. His surrealist pop style playfully counters the tone of his often-sombre narrative, with the examination of the plethora of human experience remaining the chief creative focus for Sarcita and the continuing unfolding of work.

The artist has participated in numerous exhibitions in his native Indonesia and been the recipient of several emerging artist awards including at the Taman Tino Sidin Art Museum in Yogyakarta.
