

- 1) Each image is prepared in a 3D digital format. Each element is modelled on the computer individually. This takes about 15-30 hours
- 2) Preparing the surface takes approximately 20 days. Each canvas is primed with 15-20 layers of gesso and then wet sanded
- 3) For each separate element, I tape the form and cover the rest of the canvas before I paint. With the amount of detail in my paintings, each layer can take 2-8 hours to tape and cover.
- **4)** Each element in the composition needs to dry before I apply paint to the next element.
- 5) Once I'm ready to paint. I mix each colour.
- 6) The airbrush needs to be cleaned between colours.
- 7) In order to achieve a flat and smooth paint application, have to apply several layers of paint.

I used to paint with oil and traditional brushes, and my current paintings (with airbrush) take me about three times as long to make. I choose the airbrush because of the result it produces despite taking so much time.
