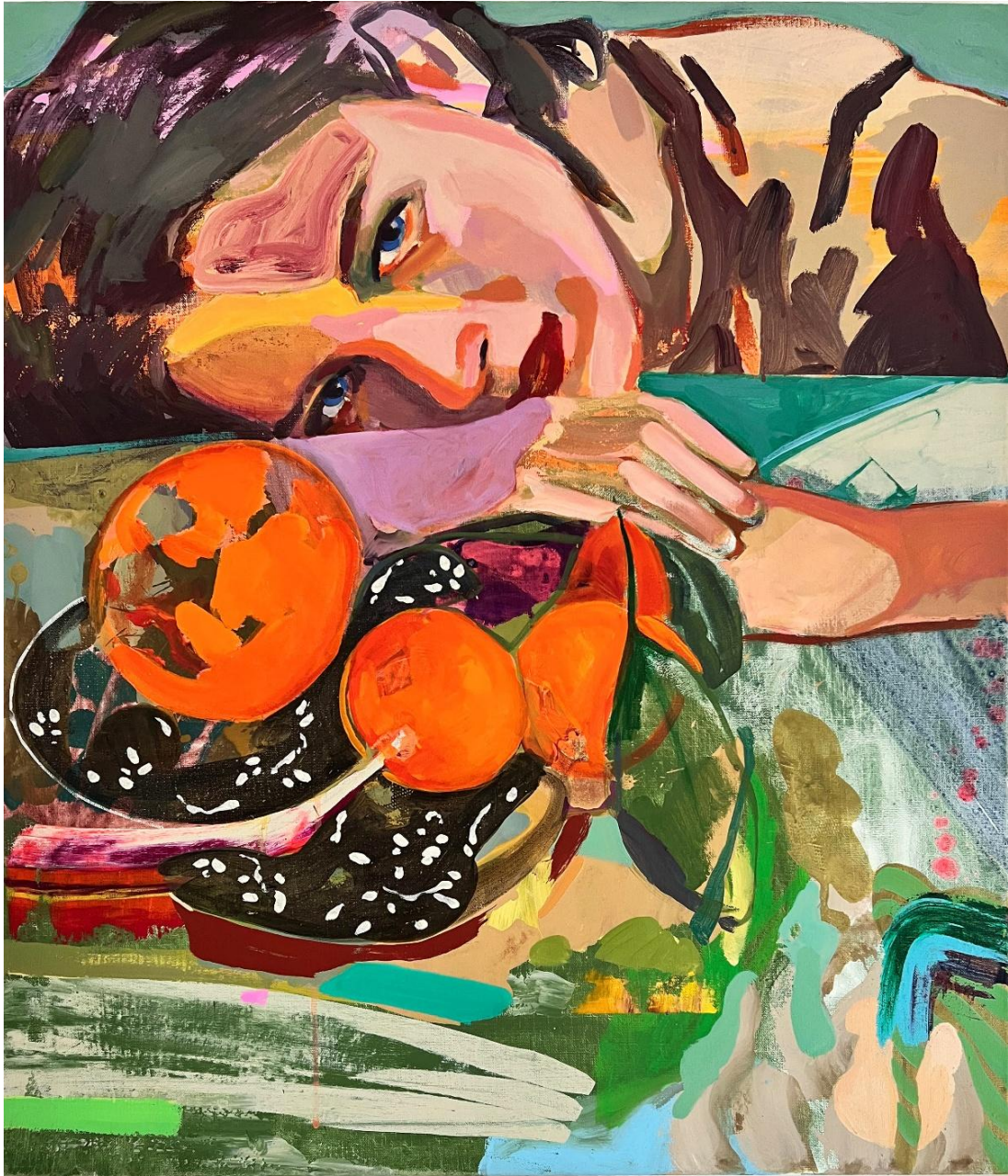

career overview | Attilio Esposito is a contemporary visual artist living in Lecco, Italy. His works aims to depict suspended images in an embryonic state that then develop within the mind of the observer.

More recently the artist's practice has evolved in a new direction, moving from careful control of form toward a freer and more instinctive approach. This transitional phase reflects both continuity with his earlier work and a desire to evolve naturally and progressively beyond the meticulous reproduction we have come to know Esposito by.

Esposito has exhibited extensively in northern Italy in both solo and group shows and has enjoyed a decades long career as a professional artist.

why we love it?

Attilio blends remarkable realism with remarkable fantasy. His is a true reflection of what might be a suspended plasticine reference. I see human anatomy, metaphysical formations and the utterly unknown. His work challenges, calls you nearer, rather than leaving you quizzical and disturbed as surreal work sometimes can. Attilio's work feels honest so it traverses between 'what is' and 'what could be' effortlessly.

career overview | Through warped, circular scenes, Elina transforms memories and feelings into autobiographical works, reimagining the human form through the lens of her own emotional experiences. Her meticulous and intentional approach to painting results in expressive, surrealistic figures that are both analysed and reconstructed.

With a background in tattoo design, Ojakangas moved on from ink work and into studio oil painting after she completed her art studies at the Gerleborg School in Stockholm.

This emerging artist is set to rise with unwavering commitment to deepening her practice and an inherent penchant for meticulous execution. As of 2026, Ojakangas is studying at the Swedish Academy of Realist Art in Simrishamn, and has openly identified that this series of works for 'In Time' mark her resultant technical development.

why we love it?

Elina's work is fluid, circular, dynamic; always moving. With geometry that lends from cubism, it's decidedly feminine yet robust. Her colour palette is subtle compared with many of her contemporary peers who tend to reflect the brash and vibrant pigments of our overly digitised world. Elina's hues are harmonious, complementary...shadowy and sophisticated, yet still whimsical.

"Technique has been the focus of these works. Still working primarily from imagination and memory, I have imbued more dynamism and symbology in this body of work and in that way, played with the concept of time as a movement."

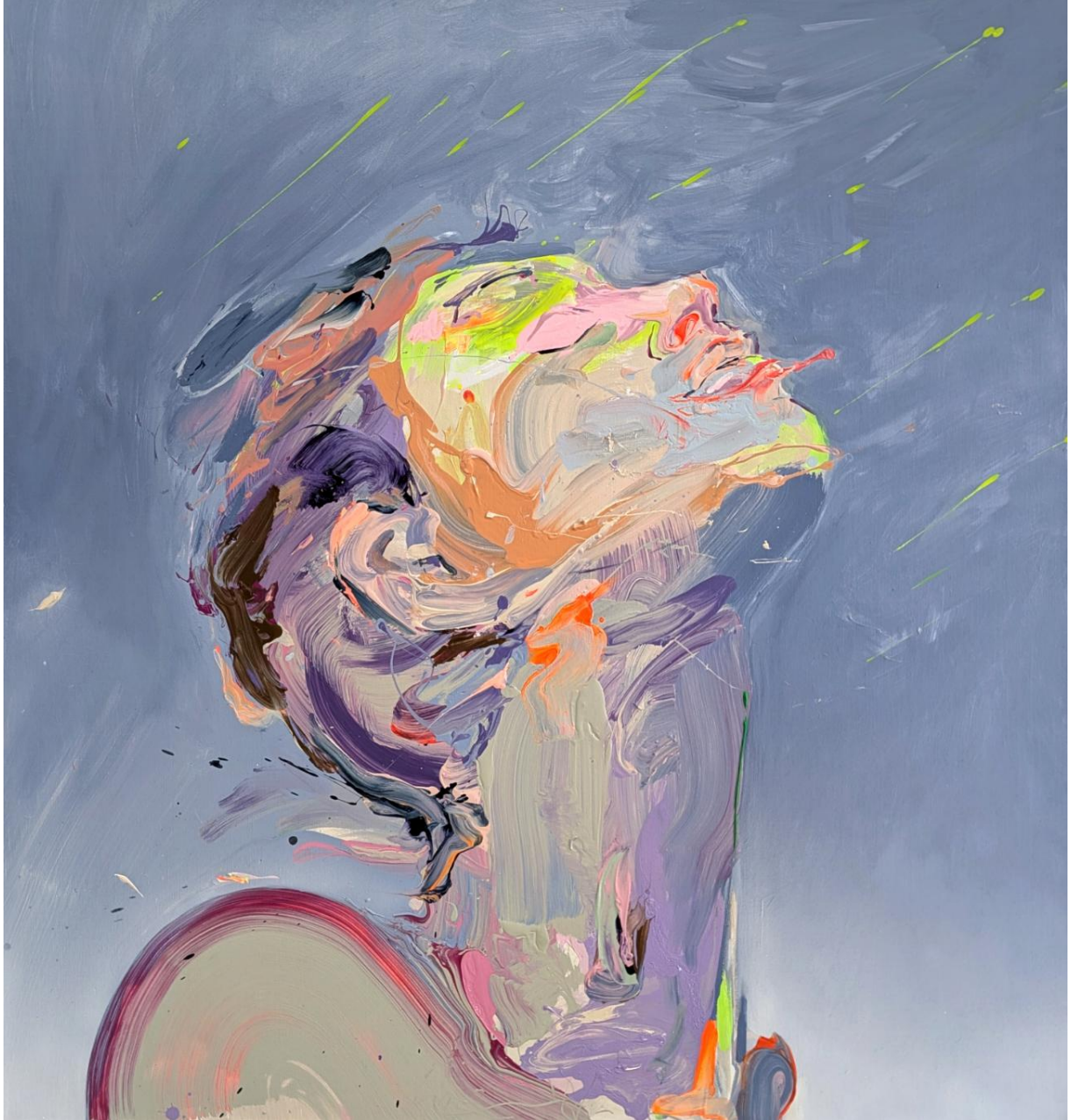
"I ended up going full circle on this series. I had two pieces that were being worked on but the gradient work within them just started feeling too much like my previous cleaner abstracts.

I'm making a conscious effort to move away from that aesthetic, and those pieces just felt like I was falling back into old patterns.

I work fast and intuitively, painting wet-into-wet so pigments bleed, blend, and bloom in ways that are partly guided and partly surrendered to gravity and chemistry, giving each surface a sense of urgency and life." – Erik Minter

career overview | Flora Castiglia was immersed in the world of art from childhood. Her mother, also an artist, worked from a home studio, fostering an environment of creativity and artistic discipline.

Contemplative and visually compelling, Castiglia's paintings explore the relationship between the inside and the outside. Flora's style is often characterized by the reoccurring engagement with geometric, yet non-restrictive, playful forms of stripes, circles and diamond-shaped grids that merge with a recurring motif of nature.

The artist is represented by Galerie Masurel in France and Escat Gallery in Spain, with further representation across Argentina, London, and Switzerland. Castiglia has participated in solo and group shows around the world and is a listed artist with the Contemporary Art Now (CAN) Art Fair in Madrid. Her work featured in Australian interiors magazine *Home Beautiful*.

why we love it?

Flora has nailed the personal, imperfect, and nuanced style of expressionism beautifully. Album covers inform her earlier work. And I still see, still sense this influence, subtly in the repetitive symbols, the tapering tails and accented spikes she punctuates her patterns with. Flora consistently stays true to her style; true to herself, evidence she is continually reflecting inward while still expressing outward to our aesthetic benefit.

statement

"Not everything has to be seen as it is. Encrypted information must be decoded. Nothing is simple and ephemeral nor literal. Some of my paintings take a literal diaristic approach through incorporation of words and letters, which makes them not only deeply personal but also anagrammatic, encouraging an active looking: to stop and linger for a bit longer, to search and explore. Meaning is underneath."

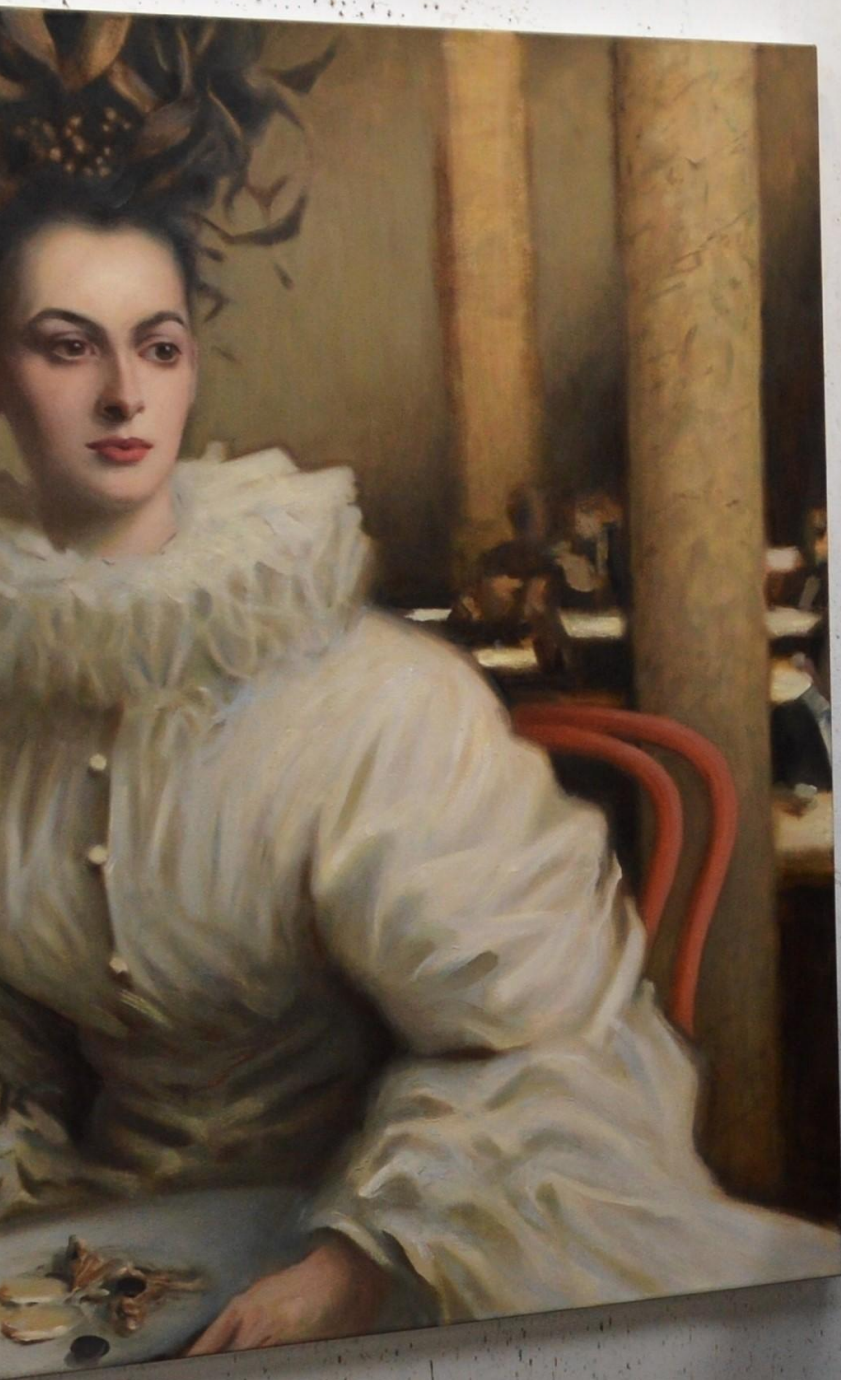
